LADOT Rolls Out the TAP Truck to Promote its Limited Edition TAP Cards

The new limited edition LADOT TAP cards are digital wallets that replace current LADOT paper passes and tickets beginning June 1, 2013. Customers can load LADOT passes, discounted multi-trip ticket books, and stored value (cash) on our TAP cards. Metro fare media also can be loaded on LADOT TAP cards. Get the Metro EZ Pass and ride both LADOT and Metro services with one card.
