Los Angeles Department of Transportation Announces People St 2018 Plaza Application Window

LOS ANGELES, CA (February 20, 2018)

The Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) and the People St program is pleased to announce that the Spring 2018 application window for Plazas will open from Monday, April 2 through Thursday, May 31. People St is an application-based program that provides eligible community organizations with a process to transform underused areas of L.A.'s largest public asset — our 7,500 miles of city streets — into active, vibrant, and accessible public space. As part of the People St partnership, community partners play a vital role in conducting outreach to build neighborhood support, raising funds for material furnishings and maintenance, and providing project site management.
